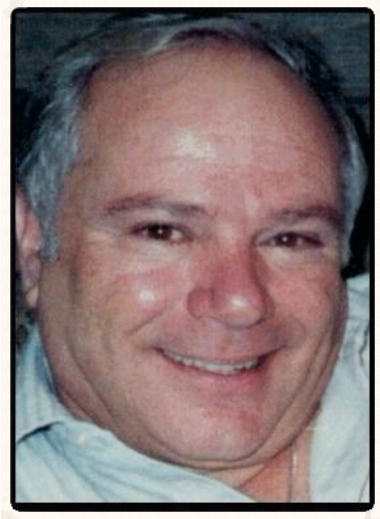


In Memory of

Michael Anthony Lopergolo, Jr., 78, of Vineland, passed away on Monday, December 7, 2015, in Philadelphia. He was born in Philadelphia to the late Michael Sr. and Millie (Dauito) Lopergolo, before moving to Vineland where he attended Sacred Heart High School. He was an active member of the New Jersey National Guard in the late 50's and early 60's.
