Zinaida "Zina" Chiola, nee Schpakow, 67, of Millville died Monday, July 23, 2012, at the University of Pennsylvania Rittenhouse Hospice after a short, but intense, fight against cancer.

Born in Germany on Aug. 27, 1944, of Russian parents, she immigrated to the Millville area via Ellis Island at the age of 5. She graduated from Millville High School in 1963 and the Peirce School of Business in 1965. During her first job at Lucy Ann Bakery, she met her husband of 46 years, Michael Chiola. After marrying in April of 1966, she worked for the family business, Chiola's Pharmacy. During the mid-'80s Zina also managed the Millville Airport Restaurant and Lounge. Until her passing, she was employed by Rite Aid.

Zina's most beloved pastime was spending time with her grandchildren. Her many hobbies included gardening, gourmet cooking, entertaining, studying Italian and traveling. Zina was an advocate for the children of our community and held various positions with the Millville PTA and as treasurer for the NJ State PTA.
